SUBJECT: STATE MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE CONTROL OF INVASIVE NON-INDIGENOUS SPECIES

WHEREAS, Louisiana's flora, fauna, public health and its natural environment have suffered in the past and will continue to be challenged by the serious impacts of invasive, non-indigenous species, and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries has been named by the Governor as the lead agency in forming a multi-discipline task force to develop a State Invasive Species Management Plan (SISMP), and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the National Invasive Species Act of 1996 called for development of state plans for controlling aquatic nuisance species, and federal funds are now available to cost-share the implementation of SISMPs.

<u>THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED</u> that the Louisiana Wildlife Federation supports the development of a comprehensive state management plan for preventing introductions of invasive, non-indigenous species, limiting the spread of established populations, and reducing the adverse ecological, economic, social and public health impacts created by invasive non-indigenous species in Louisiana.
