Resolution No. 16D, 2012

SUBJECT: ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF THE NEED TO RESPECT AND SUPPORT PRIVATE LAND OWNERSHIP

<u>WHEREAS</u>, approximately eighty percent (80%) of Louisiana's coastal marshes and ninety percent (90%) of its forests are privately owned, and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, much of this land is managed for wildlife, both terrestrial and aquatic, by the landowners in consultation with biologists and foresters, and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, many of these landowners provide access to portions of their properties not currently under lease restrictions when permission is requested and conservation laws are observed, and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, it behooves the wildlife conservation community to acknowledge and respect the private property rights of landowners, and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, many current wildlife management areas that provide public hunting and fishing opportunities are owned by private landowners, and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, a collaborative effort between the public and private sector, in conjunction with conservation organizations, will ensure Louisiana's claim as the "Sportsman's Paradise".

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Louisiana Wildlife Federation (LWF) calls upon the state of Louisiana to acknowledge the private landowners' contribution to wildlife by including this acknowledgement in various publications such as the "Louisiana Conservationist" and "Watermarks."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the LWF will work with the State on appropriate language for this acknowledgement.

Adopted by the Louisiana Wildlife Federation in Convention Assembled, March 11, 2012 in Covington, Louisiana.
